About joining social insurance

Regarding joining of social health insurance (Shakai Hoken), the law exempts “those who are hired for a specified period of two months or less.” Due to the revision of the law, the rule for joining will be changed from October 2022, and basically all people will be required to join social health insurance from the day they join the company.

Although Shakai Hoken deduction are high, they are not calculated per day. Even if you sign up for a few days, you will have to pay Shakai Hoken for the whole month. Also, if you change jobs in the same month, you joined Shakai Hoken, you will also have to pay the Shakai Hoken for the new place of work. Starting this month, changing jobs repeatedly in a brief period of time can become a big expense.

Declaration Form of Tax Deduction

The declaration form is provided with your salary statement this month. Before you submit, make sure you fill in all the information and attach necessary documents. If you do not submit them, the tax office will calculate your tax as if you have no dependents (even if you actually do). In addition, if you worked in different companies during 2022, submit the withholding slips of 2022 (Reiwa 4 Gensen Choushuuhyou) from other companies.

If you send money to your dependents living outside of Japan, you need to submit the remittance statements as well. The remittance statements are necessary for each of your dependents. For example, if you send money to your wife and daughter in the Philippines, you have to have separate statements for each of them. If you send money to your wife all together, you cannot have your daughter as your dependent. Please double-check your remittance statements. We also ask you to fill in your name and address on the three forms. If you do not submit the forms, you will not be able to file a tax deduction declaration.

About visa renewal

At Shin-Ei, we can do the visa renewal process for employees and dependents. You can do the process without missing work, as there is no need for you to go to immigration. In addition to the visa renewal, we renew the Zairyu Card for those who have a permanent visa, request a permanent visa and help with the visa of relatives who want to come from Brazil (Eligibility).
