## Zairyu Card (Residence Card) Renewal for Permanent Residents

Permanent residents don't need to apply for the extension of period of stay, but they need to apply for the extension of the valid period of the Zairyu Card. Please check the period of validity of the card shown at the bottom and apply for the extension before it expires. Shin-Ei can support the application for 1,000 yen. You need to provide your passport, Zairyu Card, a photo (3x4cm) and a signature on the application form. For more information, contact one of our staffs.




## When You Renew Your Zairyu Card . . .

Recently, banks are strengthening the control over personal data on the Zairyu Card. They are demanding for those whose visa and Zairyu Card expired to provide information on the new Zairyu Card. Some of you may have already received a notification letter from the bank. They started this as a part of crime countermeasures such as money laundering and terrorist financing resulting from account transfers and sales.

When you renew your visa or Zairyu Card, or even when you move, make sure to provide your new Zairyu Card information to your bank. The same goes for Shin-Ei. When you do so, provide us the new information. In addition, if it's either Shizuoka Bank or Hamamatsu Iwata Shinyo Kinko, we can provide them your Zairyu Card information on behalf of you. If you need, contact us.

## Final Tax Return

Final tax return can be filed as below. Please note that during the period, they don't accept documentations at the Tax Office. It's open during weekdays and 1 Sunday. If you need to file, we recommend you to do on Sunday. You might need My Number. Bring the My Number notification card or actual My Number card with you
