Car Troubles in Summer

The most common troubles are air conditioning and battery. The air conditioning system takes much more power to cool down the inside of your car than to keep the cool temperature. The car battery has a heavy load when starting the engine. Therefore, if you use the air conditioner in the summer and run a short distance so many times, the battery will run out easily. Even if you drive a long distance, driving at slow speed or stopping your car for long time can damage the battery.

Each car has a generator called alternator, and it charges the battery and to power the electrical system when its engine is running. However, if the traveling speed is slow, the efficiency of power generation will deteriorate and the battery will not be fully charged. In addition, the brake lights will consume electricity while the vehicle is stopped. If you are caught in a traffic jam and stop your car for a long time, you may easily run out of battery. The regular maintenance is the key to prevent the car troubles in summer.
