Service by appointment at the Consulate General of Brazil

To go to the Brazilian Consulate, it is necessary to register online and schedule the date and time. It is necessary to fill 5 pages of information to register, which can be difficult for those who are not used to it. In addition, you may not be possible to schedule the appointment on the date and time you wish, depending on availability. Therefore, if you intend to go to the Consulate, we recommend that you prepare in advance. In particular, those renewing their visa for the first time will need the original birth and marriage certificate issued within 6 months, and will often go to the Consulate to obtain a certified copy. Plan the first visa renewal, including applying for the original copy from Brazil. For certified copies, Shin-Ei offers the service to act as a representative.
