About salary seizure

Starting in 2014, the city and finance office began to send a notice to the company to seize part of the salary due to late payment of residence tax, vehicle tax and fines for late payment of national health insurance. Upon receiving this notice, the company is obliged to seize part of the employee's salary and pay it to the city hall or finance office.

The amount that can be seized varies each month depending on the "number of dependents" and "amount of social security, income tax, residential tax, pension expenses" that are deducted from the salary.

The company must calculate the amount that can be seized from salary each month and continue to seize from salary until all overdue debts are paid off. If the payment is difficult, you may be able to change the foreclosure amount to a fixed amount every month by notifying the city hall or the finance office, so please contact us immediately.

About the permanent visa

Many people want to live in Japan for a long time without having to renew their visa. We will explain about important documents to obtain a permanent visa.

1. The last 5 years of the Municipal and Provincial Tax Payment Certificate (NOUZEI SHOUMEISHO) and Taxation Certificate (KAZEI SHOUMEISHO).

The tax certificate contains the person's income and the number of dependents. The visa can be denied if the amount of income is low in relation to the number of dependents. On tax payment certificate shows payment status. The visa can be denied if there is a lack of payment, and even paying during the evaluation of the documents can be denied as well.

2. Retirement record

It is the history that proves the type of contribution, contribution period and the company where you were during the contribution period. If there is a lack of payment or a period that was not registered in retirement, the permanent visa may be denied.

These documents must be presented without fail. Each person has a different case but be sure to pay taxes and retirement.

Due to the revision of the Civil Code from April 2022, adulthood will change from 20 years to 18 years. As a result, contracts can be signed if you are over 18 years old and, of course, car sales contracts can also be signed. Even if you are a high school student, if you are 18 years old or older, you can order the vehicle yourself and, in principle, you can celebrate a contract. Even though a person over 18 years of age can legally purchase a car, in many cases they will need financial help from their parents. Don't let your child buy a vehicle and drive without insurance and without the parents' knowledge.
